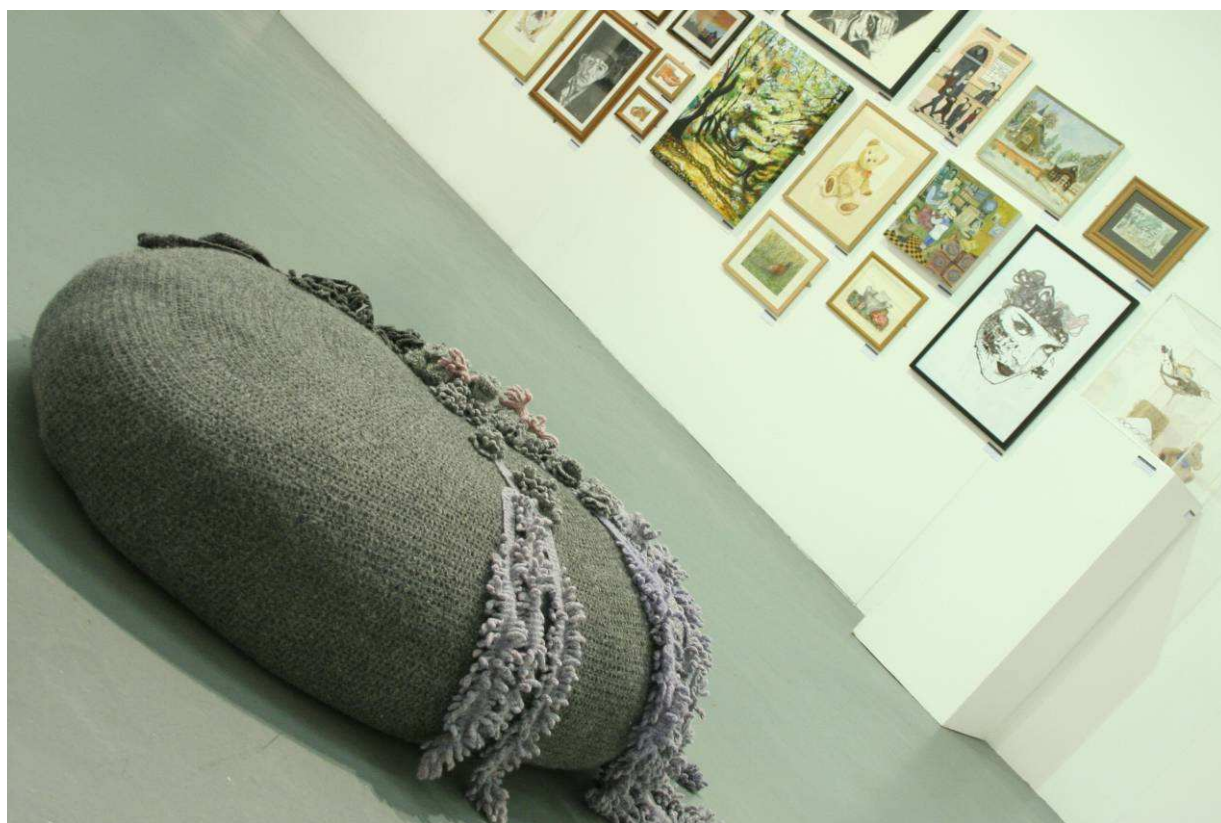

ENTRY FORM 2010

Exhibition The exhibition will take place at the Turnpike Gallery, Civic Square, Leigh WN7 1EB from 13 March – 17 April 2010.

Theme There is no specific theme for this exhibition.

Eligibility Artists, including professional, amateur and students, living and/or working in the borough of Wigan; plus young people aged 5-16.

Conditions of Entry As with last year's exhibition, there will be no selection process by which works are included or not included in the exhibition. However, works which are deemed to be offensive or upsetting to the general public will not be accepted.

Wall-based works (paintings, drawings, photographs, etc) will be accepted and should be framed 'ready to hang' with mirror plates (available from hardware stores) and your name on the reverse of the picture.

Three dimensional works will be accepted. The gallery has a limited supply of plinths and display cases for display for small objects. Larger single piece sculptures to be placed on the floor will also be accepted. Exhibits which are light-weight and need to be hung from the ceiling will also be included where possible. Complex installations and multi-media works will be difficult to accommodate.

Entry fee There is no entry fee to exhibit. Maximum of 1 work per person.

Submission of Entries All artworks should be brought to the gallery, unwrapped and ready to hang, on **Thursday 4th, Friday 5th, Saturday 6th or Monday 8th March**. Opening times are **Mon-Fri 10.00am-6.00pm; Sat 9.30am-3.30pm**.

Deadline for submissions is 6pm MONDAY 8TH MARCH 2010

Installation Installation of the exhibition will be made by Louise Clennell, Turnpike Gallery Co-ordinator and Martyn Lucas, Visual Arts Officer, Turnpike Gallery.

Return of works All works must be collected from the gallery on Saturday 17th (after 2pm), Monday 19th or Tuesday 20th April, during opening hours.
