

Active Life Swimming Pool Family and Child Admission Policy

A responsible adult should accompany all children under the age of 8 and/or any non swimmers into the swimming pool. The adult must go into the water with the children they are accompanying and will maintain a constant watch over the children for whom they are responsible.

The maximum number of children under the age of 8 that can be supervised by one adult is two.

A responsible adult must accompany children aged 3 years and under into the water on a one-to-one basis. The sole exception to this is if both children are wearing armbands or other approved buoyancy aids.

Children aged 4 – 7 years must be accompanied into the water by a responsible adult on a maximum two-to-one basis.

One child aged 3 years or under and one child aged 4-7 years can be accompanied by 1 adult if the child aged 3 years or under wears approved buoyancy aids.

The purpose of this child admissions policy is to help safeguard that group of pool users who historically are most at risk from drowning in swimming pools. It is not intended to stop children having fun and enjoying swimming, nor intended to make life difficult for parents/carers.
